

RESOLUTION No. 2022-038

**RESOLUTION OF THE UTE MOUNTAIN UTE TRIBAL COUNCIL  
REFERENCE: Approval to Rename the Gore Range to the Nuchu Range**

WHEREAS, the Constitution and By-Laws of the Ute Mountain Ute Tribe, approved June 6, 1940, and subsequently amended, provides in Article III that the governing body of the Ute Mountain Ute Tribe ("Tribe") is the Ute Mountain Ute Tribal Council and sets forth in Article V the powers of the Tribal Council exercised in this Resolution;

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has the duty to protect the assets of the Tribe and promote the best interests of the Tribe and its members;

WHEREAS, the Utes historically occupied the area which today is referred to as the Gore Range but were forcibly evicted from the area by the United States;

WHEREAS, the Gore Range is named after George Gore, an Irishman who came to the area temporarily to hunt and who abused the privilege by killing thousands of buffalos, bears, elk, and deer with no respect for the wildlife or the indigenous people who depended on the animals for their welfare and regarded the animals as sacred;

WHEREAS, there is an effort today to rename the Gore Range to a name that is more respectful of the indigenous populations that inhabited the area since time immemorial; and

WHEREAS, the action taken by this Resolution is in the best interests of the Tribe.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby approves the renaming of the Gore Range to the Nuchu Range; and

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Ute Mountain Tribal Council authorizes the Chairman to sign this Resolution and further authorizes him to take such action as may be necessary to carry out the intent of this Resolution.

The foregoing Resolution was duly adopted this 9th day of March, 2022.


